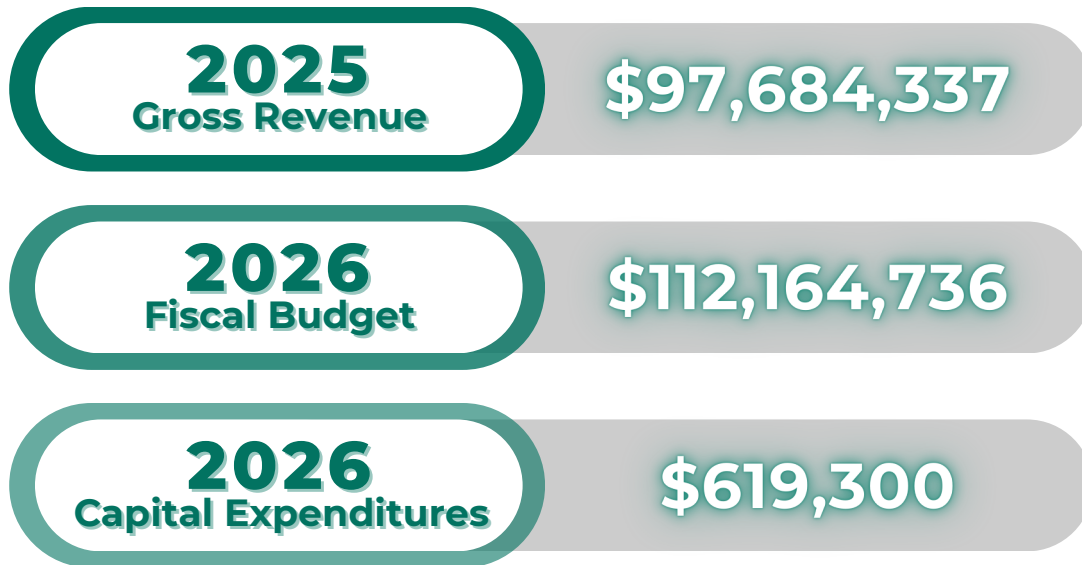

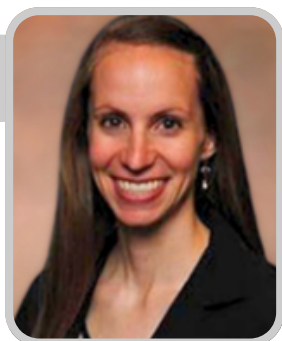
DAISY Award Recipients at CBMC in 2025

She provides care for women at every stage of life, offering a wide range of services including well-woman exams, preventive screenings, contraceptive counseling, and IUD placement, as well as various in-office procedures, and advanced surgical expertise in laparoscopic and robotic procedures, hysteroscopy, and other minimally invasive and traditional techniques.

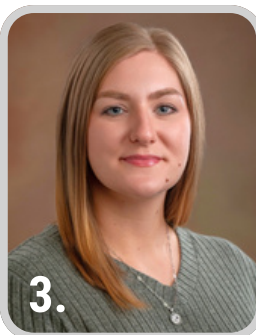
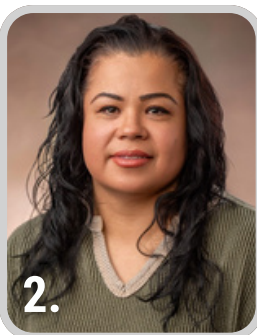
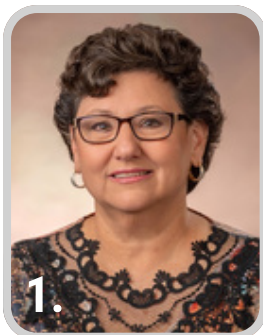
Debbie Snyder achieves APRN - Becomes Provider

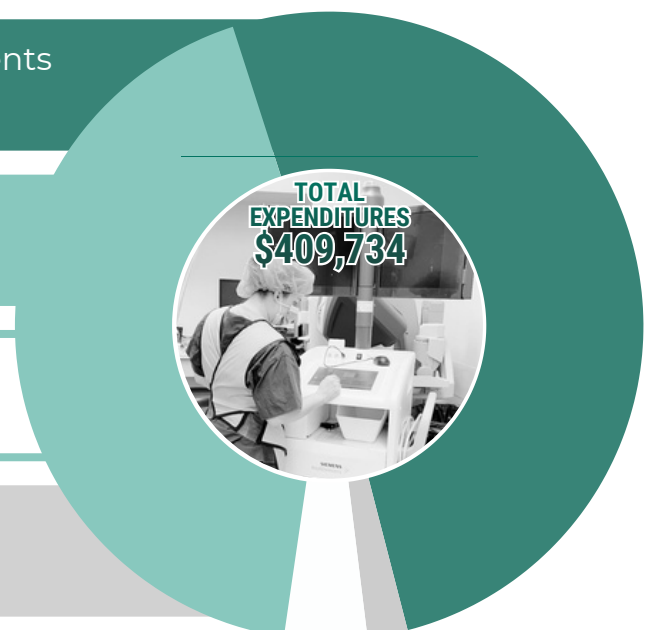
